From the Mosquito Creek vineyard at Joanna, (Wrattenbully Region), in the South East of South Australia, we have continued our long tradition of producing the highest quality Cabernets.

From the outstanding 2008 vintage we have selected the best barrels to produce a wine to rival our previous award winning Cabernets, such as the 2000 Barrel Selection (Top 100 Australian Wines) and 2002 Cabernet (trophy and gold and Top 100 Australian Wines).

The grapes are from the classic 'terra rossa over limestone soil' from a low yielding crop, hand picked and aged for over 2 years in seasoned and new French oak barrels.

Full bodied with intense but elegant berry fruit flavours.

This premium release will benefit from careful cellaring and will develop and mature significantly in the bottle for up to 10 years.
